

# **FALSE LASHES WITH VICTOR**

## **STEP 1 0F 9**

Remove the lash carefully with tweezers from the container to ensure the lashes retain their shape. Measure the false lash to the eye. The lashes can be trimmed if needed (from the outside longest portion) with MAC safety scissors. Curl the lashes.

**STEP 2 OF 9**Apply a generous coat of mascara.

**STEP 3 OF 9**Apply a thin black liquid eyeliner to disguise where the natural and false lash meet.

### **STEP 4 0F 9**

Blacken the lash band to help the lash band blend in with your natural lash line

## **STEP 5 0F 9**


Lay down the proper amount of Duo Lash Adhesive on the false lash, waiting 15 seconds to allow the adhesive to become tacky.

STEP 6 OF 9

Bend the lash to mold it into the proper shape and for easier application.





#### **STEP 7 0F 9**

Apply false lash (laying down the center first and then securing the ends. Use the end of a brush to push the lash down onto the lash line prior to the adhesive completely drying.





#### **STEP 8 0F 9**

Adjust the lash with the eye open by 'fluffing up' or pushing down until both are even.
